Showmanship

This is part of a species show. We start with the Senior showmanship class followed by the Intermediate, then Junior. This is always done after the classes are completed per species. BUT the judge does watch during each class on how you are handling and watching the judge.

SENIOR- completed 9th grade and above

INTERMEDIATE- completed 6th grade-8th grade

JUNIOR- completed 3rd grade-5th grade

We encourage everyone to try showmanship and you do receive a premium for doing it. If a 4-Her wins intermediate or senior showmanship in a species, they are the participant in the Overall Showmanship show on Saturday! If the champion cannot participate then they need to tell MaryAnn ASAP and then the spot goes to the reserve champion. **In overall showmanship – you show the animals that you won with.**

RIBBON AUCTION

If you have signed up for the auction deadline – THURSDAY – at 5 p.m.- You must be ready to go with your animal and ribbon on Saturday at 3:30 p.m. and the Livestock Committee will direct you in the order and where to go. If you come after your species is through the auction, you will NOT be able to go through.

You are expected to be on time and ready for directions to make the auction run smoothly.

BARN CLEANUP

It is the expectation that ALL livestock youth will help with the ENTIRE CLEANUP PROCESS of the barns. The livestock committee will give directions in the cleaning process. If you are not there to help, no one will help load your equipment or animals.
